FACE MASKS



We will try to be outdoors as much as possible in 2021, including for meals.

In our guidelines from the Colorado Department of Health, masks are required indoors for activities and outdoors when social distancing is not guaranteed. When we think of certain activities for summer 2021 like soccer or Gaga, those are activities that will require masks outdoors. We will have signage up to remind the campers and staff of areas that require masks.

Exceptions: eating, sleeping, swimming, brushing teeth, showering, any time social distancing can be maintained.
