



We ask for your patience and flexibility as we move closer to camp and receive new guidelines. **We do not have a timeline for when we expect new guidelines.** Our most recent guidelines came from June 2020 from the State of Colorado Department of Health. We will need to go through and see what changed and how that might affect camp operations. We will stay in contact to update you on any changes as we approach camp.

Optional Activities

The check-in process this summer will be different to follow COVID-19 guidelines. There will be no option to add optional activities at check-in. These must be added prior to your camper's arrival via your camp InTouch account. Please call the camp office for availability.

At this time, we are evaluating how to safely run all of our programs and additional options. If we do not feel we can safely operate with the guidelines given, we may choose to remove certain programs. If this happens, you will be notified and refunded any optional activity fees.

POTENTIAL COVID CASE AT CAMP

A positive COVID case in a cabin will result in that cabin isolating (and the corresponding family group if necessary). Contact tracing will begin and anyone who is identified as a close contact will isolate as well. All parents of isolated campers will be notified as well as Grand County Public Health.

Any staff member involved will have to get a negative COVID test before returning to work.
