Bunkmate Requests

Traditional campers age 7-12 may make one cabin-mate request.

- ◆ Must be no more than 12 months apart in age
- ◆ Must be mutual request between both campers
- ◆ Requesting more than one cabin mate may void any requests
- ◆ Placements are not guaranteed
- ◆ Two-week campers may not request one-week campers to be a cabin mate
