ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF

Teen Director

Responsible for coordination, scheduling, support and leadership of the Challenger and Two-Week Programs (ages 10-14) in cabin life and programs. Supervise and support up to 14 staff. Responsible for organizing and caring for all program supplies, activities and main camp cleaning supplies. Must have previous camp experience and be at least 21 years old. Lifeguard certification is a plus.

Day Camp Director

Responsible for the coordination of program, staff, and support and leadership of counselors during day camp programs. Responsible for reviewing, maintaining, and evaluating camp program. Main liaison between camp and parents. Must have previous camp experience and be at least 21 years of age.

CAMP STAFF

Cabin Counselor –Male (full on those that identify as female staff)

Main Leader of Fun! Provide leadership for 8-10 campers in a cabin group. You should be able to manage stress, prioritize, plan ahead, run at least one activity area, and be mindful of own physical and emotional needs. All cabin counselors must be at least 18 years old. Lifeguard certification is a plus.

Cabin Counselor with Specialty Focus

Perform Cabin Counselor duties but program area responsibility would be implementation of assigned program area. Ensure staff are equipped for their roles and quality of program to increase learning and enjoyment of all campers. Will collaborate with village directors on staff evaluations. Areas of focus include; Arts & Crafts, Target & Outdoors, STEM, and Sports & Games. Certifications a plus for archery and riflery.

Challenger Counselors – Male (full on those that identify as female staff)

Responsible for coordinating and supervising the programming for oldest teens in regular camp (ages 13-14). You will remain with this unique teen group for all day and evening programs. Preferably 20 years or older and 2 years camp experience. Lifeguard certification is a plus.

Day Camp Staff – Female and Male

Perform group counselor duties with a day camp of local and non-local campers. Ability to run programs for a group of up to 10 kids with a co-counselor, manage stress, handle situations, run programs, and flexibility are required.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM (LTP)/BACKCOUNTRY TRIP STAFF

CIT Director

Responsible for scheduling, coordinating, and leading the CIT (Counselor-in-Training) program. Maintain positive relationship with cabin staff in order to keep communication open for the benefit of CIT campers. Promote enrollment within the Leadership Training Program and assist in trips staff oversight. Maintain an active role in staff development. Assist in camp programs, travel logistics, and trail department duties as needed. Must be at least 21 years of age with clean driving record and previous camp experience, demonstrated leadership, ropes course experience and capable of assuming an administrative role within the LTP and camp.

LIT (Leader-In-Training) Leader - Male (full on those that identify as female staff)

Responsible for leading 3 sessions of the LIT program as well as leading Adventure trips throughout the summer. Backpacking experience, outdoor living skills, and group work with teens a must. Experience planning lessons and teaching leadership skills required. Experience teaching leadership skills in a wilderness setting preferred. Preferably 21+ with a good driving record.

Trip Leader - Female (full on those that identify as male staff)

Responsible for leading in-camp activities and out of camp trips for campers in backpacking, rafting, and mountain biking programs. Previous experience leading wilderness trips and/or student experience with NOLS, Outward Bound, or similar programs required. Demonstrated leadership skills and work with teens important. Must be 21+ with a good driving record.

BARN STAFF

Cabin Counselor Wrangler (CCW)

Perform Cabin Counselor duties but program area teaching responsibility would be in the various levels of our Riding Program. All CCWs are required to attend a one week Barn training prior to regular staff training. Horse experience is a must.

SUPPORT STAFF

Kitchen Staff (x6)

Responsible for food preparation for all camp meals. Responsible for cleanliness of camp kitchen, dining hall facility, and dishes.

Office Assistant

Assists camp administrative personnel in various tasks in all aspects of camp operations. Primary responsibilities will include, but not limited to; all office duties, coordinating the distribution of staff and camper mail, help organize and return lost and found, help organize and run the camp store and other administrative duties as assigned. Program/cabin duties as needed. Office experience and clean driving record preferred.
\$317/week, prefer May 1st - August 10th

Travel Coordinator

Responsible for safe transportation of campers and staff in all facets of the camp program. This includes, but is not limited to, airport arrivals/departures, dropping off and picking up adventure trip campers and staff at trail heads (Wyoming, Rocky Mountain National Park, etc.), general errands and taking ill/injured campers/staff to the medical clinic if needed. Must be at least 21 years old, organized, responsible, and have a clean driving record.
