Mandatory Camp Forms

Below is a list of MANDATORY camp forms to be completed as soon as possible and no later than 30 days prior to your campers arrival at camp. You can find them on your CampInTouch account under 'Forms and Documents.'

1. Health History
2. Physician's Examination
3. Immunization Record
4. Healthcare Authorization
5. Conduct Agreement
6. Information for Counselors
7. Rafting Waiver (if applicable)



Medication at Camp

All medication and homeopathic treatments MUST be in ORIGINAL containers and are required to be turned in to the Health Center staff at check-in.

Over the counter medications are stocked in our Health Center and administered by our Health Center staff according to our camp physician's standing orders.

Homeopathic treatments, per Colorado State Law, must come with parental and physician consent in original container.
