Updated resident camp guidelines for summer 2021 have come out. We are still reviewing and making decisions for what that will look like for CCO. Please keep an eye on your CampInTouch login email, this is where we will send updates.

Check In/Check Out

We are working to solidify a plan for Check-In and Check-Out this year that will keep all of our campers, their families, and our staff safe. At this time, we are expecting to run The Check-In process in a drive through format.

Cars will pull up to a station, campers will check in, get their cabin assignment, and start the health check process. All campers will go through a lice check, COVID symptom screening, and health check. Cars will then pull through to a designated luggage drop off point where campers will meet their cabinmates and counselors.

We are expecting the Check-Out process to mirror this Check-In process.
